Instructions to Authors

CAPRINAE News publishes work dealing with conservation, research and management of wild sheep, goats and goat-antelopes worldwide. It is published once or twice per year, depending on the material submitted.

Contributions can be: **Short Notes** (300 words), **Short Papers** (1,500 words), **Reviews** (300 words) or information on activities regarding Caprinae, *e.g.* announcements or abstracts of conferences or meetings. Pictures of species, habitat, landscape or other graphic material may illustrate articles. Diagrams, drawings and captions should be legible after reduction. Maps should always indicate the scale and the North.

References to publications in the text should be made by name of author and year of publication. The list of references, alphabetically ordered should appear at the end of the text. Name(s) of author(s) should be followed by the year of publication, the complete title of the work, the name of the journal (in italics), volume and page numbers. For example:

Bocci A., S. Menapace, S. Alemanno, S. Lovari - 2015. Conservation introduction of the threatened Apennine chamois *Rupicapra pyrenaica ornata*: post-release dispersal differs between wild-caught and captive founders. *Oryx* 50: 128-133.

If, in the references, there are two or more books or papers with the same author and the same year of publication, a lower-case *a*, *b*, etc., should be added to the year of publication both in the reference list and in the text.
